Weather Portrait for the Sochi Area



GENERAL INFORMATION

The holiday resort of Sochi will be the host city for the third Russian Grand Prix. Well known for the 2014 Winter Olympics, Sochi is also one of the top summer holiday destinations in Russia with long stretches of pebble and sandy beaches as well as great hiking trails and a National Park in the nearby mountain ranges of the Western Caucasus.

CLIMATE OF SOCHI

The Greater Sochi area is one of the few locations in Russia that has a

subtropical climate with mild winters – the Caucasus Mountains shelter this part of the Black Sea from the cold Siberian winds. There are only a few days with air frost each year, and palm trees can even be found close to the coastline. Summers are mostly warm and sometimes quite humid, with sea surface temperatures rising to around 25 degrees Celsius in August. These values are actually comparable to the northern Mediterranean. The area can even experience intense heat waves with daytime highs above 35 degrees Celsius,

and the record high temperature of 39.4 degrees Celsius was recorded in the year 2000. An extreme low of -13.4 degrees Celsius was observed in 1892, however lows below -10 degrees Celsius have become rare in more recent times. Rainfall is fairly common with all months more than 100 mm of rain.

CLIMATE INFORMATION FOR END OF APRIL / FIRST DAYS OF MAY

On average, the last week of April and the first week of May bring springlike conditions with mild afternoon



temperatures of around 18 degrees Celsius before it drops off to around 10 degrees Celsius during the overnight hours. The city can expect, on average, 18 days with measurable amounts of precipitation in April and 16 days in May. Many of the rainfall events consist of heavy showers; prolonged wet periods are rare. At this time sea surface temperatures are only slowly starting to recover from winter, with typical values between 13 and 15 degrees Celsius in the first few days of May.
